- Completed Ph.D. in Business Administration or related field is strongly preferred, ABD will be considered.

- At least five years, university-level teaching experience.
- A strong focus on student engagement.
- The ability to teach standard undergraduate business curriculum (i.e. Accounting, finance, economics, marketing, organizational behaviour, business law, business strategy, business statistics and business math, human resources, or operations management).
- Demonstrated commitment to undergraduate teaching informed by research.
- Commitment to integrate Christian faith and academic excellence.
- Philosophy of life must be in accord with the policies, objectives and doctrinal statement of Ambrose;

Salary and rank will be commensurate with qualifications and experience. A relocation allowance is available.
