### Position Summary:

California Baptist University, an evangelical Christian university affiliated with the California Southern Baptist Convention, invites applications for the following faculty position. Candidates must embrace the mission of California Baptist University and evidence a clear understanding of, and commitment to, excellence in teaching, scholarship and service through the integration of the Christian faith and learning. A terminal degree in the field indicated is preferred, although candidates with a master's degree may be considered.

### Qualifications:

The department of Business in the Division of Online and Professional Studies invites applications for a full time tenure track faculty position for the Logistics, Materials, and Supply Chain Management program. The successful candidate should possess a terminal degree related to the field, although candidates with a Master's degree who are working toward a terminal degree, or have significant experience in the field, may be considered. Strong candidates will demonstrate confirmation of teaching effectiveness, exceptional oral and written communication skills, and evidence of, and/or the potential for scholarship. Faculty duties include teaching courses at undergraduate level, engaging in research and scholarship, professional involvement germane to the area of specialization, and serving with purpose and distinction within the community.

### Teaching Responsibilities:

This position involves teaching responsibilities in the undergraduate area of Logistics, Materials, and Supply Chain Management including but not limited to the areas of: logistics, materials, manufacturing, supply chain management, statistics, fulfillment, policy, procedures, protocols, finance, procurement, transportation, information technology, analytics, analysis, international logistics, planning and control, and/or decision making. Other duties may include developing or amending program curriculum, assessment of learning outcomes, and teaching in an online and/or hybrid setting. This position does require a local (Southern California) presence.
