Position Summary:

California Baptist University, an evangelical Christian university affiliated with the California Southern Baptist Convention, invites applications for the following faculty position. Candidates must embrace the mission of California Baptist University and evidence a clear understanding of, and commitment to, excellence in teaching, scholarship and service through the integration of the Christian faith and learning. A terminal degree in the field indicated is preferred, although candidates with a master's degree may be considered.

Qualifications:

The department of Business in the Division of Online and Professional Studies invites applications for a full time tenure track faculty position in Business Administration program. The successful candidate should possess a terminal degree related to the field and significant experience within the field. Strong candidates will demonstrate confirmation of teaching effectiveness, exceptional oral and written communication skills, and evidence of, and/or the potential for scholarship. Faculty duties include teaching courses at undergraduate level, engaging in research and scholarship, professional involvement germane to the area of specialization, and serving with purpose and distinction within the community.

Teaching Responsibilities:

This position involves teaching responsibilities in the graduate area of business administration with a focus on management as well as areas including, but not limited to: business finance, business statistics, international business, business law, business policy and strategy, principles of marketing, quantitative business analysis, foundations of accounting and finance, management and information systems, managerial ethics, financial management, and global business management. Other duties may include developing or amending program curriculum, assessment of learning outcomes, and teaching in an online and/or hybrid setting. This position does require a local (Southern California) presence.
