

## Call for Papers/Session Proposals for the 2017 Annual CBFA Conference hosted by Point Loma Nazarene University in San Diego, CA October 19 - 21, 2017

Plans are under way for the 37<sup>th</sup> annual CBFA conference! The theme for the 2017 conference is "More than the Bottom Line: Business Education to Change the World". We welcome your academic papers or session proposals related to this theme and other topics of interest to the CBFA membership.

## Steps to submit a session proposal:

- 1) Click on Conference Session Proposal Form and complete the electronic form.
- 2) Click on CBFA Program Chair and submit your manuscript/proposal.
  - Submissions must be in a Microsoft Word docx format
  - The file name should include the author's name and part of the document title.
  - Submit a "disguised version" with NO reference to the author(s) in the document
  - No author will be accepted as <u>lead</u> author for more than 2 sessions.

Types of session proposals being accepted:

- 1. Paper Presentations: full papers preferred (only full papers will be published in the proceedings).
- 2. Non-Paper Presentations; e.g. workshops, panels, round tables, best practice demonstrations.
- 3. Poster Presentations: opportunity to share projects under development in a reception forum

- $\bullet \hspace{0.5cm} \text{At least one author must register for and attend the conference.}$
- All paper presenters must submit the full paper <u>and</u> presentation materials; e.g. PowerPoint, Prezi, video.
- All non-paper session presenters must submit presentation materials; e.g. PowerPoint, Prezi, video.
- PLNU tech support will load all presentation materials on the A/V system in the rooms for presenters.
- All poster presenters will bring project materials to the conference to display on a free standing poster at the poster reception. Posters can be purchased from PLNU upon arrival at the conference.
