

Cornerstone University in Grand Rapids, Michigan invites applications for a traditional undergraduate position in Finance to begin fall 2018. The position is classified as a full-time tenure-track faculty position with faculty rank and base salary dependent upon educational and professional qualifications and experience. Candidates should be able to teach advanced subjects in the major in addition to effectively participating in introductory level instruction in finance. Preference will be given to those with an academic background and/or experience in financial markets, banking, and insurance. Other responsibilities include scholarly engagement in the candidate's specialization area, academic advising, student recruitment, and other departmental duties as assigned.

The successful candidate will possess a relevant advanced degree, give evidence of scholarly potential, and demonstrate a commitment to excellence in undergraduate teaching. A doctorate or concentration in Finance is preferred or an MBA with a focus in finance or a Master's degree in finance. Salary is commensurate with qualifications and experience. Review of applications begins immediately and will continue until the position is filled.
