- A vibrant faith life exemplified by church involvement, active Christian service, and a heartfelt calling to endeavors to realize Eastern's missional outcomes
- Practical background in industry or a secondary discipline is a plus, especially in consumer financial services, financial planning, business metrics, and/or health services administration
