

## Assistant Professor of Business Management

The Richard J. Bolte Sr. School of Business at Mount St. Mary's University invites teacher-scholars to apply for the tenure-track position of Assistant Professor of Business Management to begin August 2017. To be considered, the candidate will possess a Doctorate in Management and demonstrate a commitment to excellence in teaching, scholarship, and service to our academic community.

Strong mastery of teaching skills will be required to teach management courses in the Bachelors day program and Masters evening program in one or more of the following areas: general management theory/practice, managerial skill development, operations strategy, organizational behavior, business ethics, and corporate social responsibility. The candidate will teach management majors plus students from other disciplines (i.e., accounting, general business, global business, data analytics, sport management, marketing, and finance).

The candidate will be involved in the Mount's annual *Symposium on Corporate Social Responsibility*. Other duties include curriculum revision, student advising, attending faculty meetings, committee work, and maintaining a publication record in scholarly journals. The teaching load is 7 courses per year. Class sizes generally vary between 20-30 students. Candidates must be eligible for employment in the U.S. Preference will be given to teacher-scholars with management experience, a commitment to the liberal arts, and an ability to prepare young scholars for careers in business.

Established in 1808, the Mount is the second oldest Catholic institution of higher education in the United States. The main campus sits on 1,400 acres and is located close to the Baltimore and Washington, DC metropolitan areas. Accredited by the Middle States Commission on Higher Education and the International Assembly of Collegiate Business Education, the Mount enrolls 2,100 students on the Emmitsburg and Frederick, Maryland campuses.
