Tenure-Track Faculty Position Graduate Business, Leadership, and Management (BLM)

The Skinner School of Business and Technology invites applications for a full-time, tenure-track position in business, leadership, and management to help staff Trevecca's growing business program. This position may start beginning August, 2017, January 2018, or August 2018.

Key Outcomes (After the first year)

- Considered by **students** as being a Christ-centered leader who brings high levels of expertise and experience as well as an engagement that is supportive, collaborative, interesting, and creative.
- Considered by **colleagues** as relational, responsible, resourceful, and resilient.
- Considered by the broader **Trevecca Community** as collaborative, supportive, tactful, and passionate about Christian Higher Education.

Responsibilities: Teaching undergraduate and non-traditional graduate business, leadership, and management courses in the undergraduate and MBA programs. Duties will include teaching during the day, in the evening, and online as well as student advising and normal committee assignments.

Qualifications: All applicants must have a personal commitment to Jesus Christ, be able to articulate well an evangelical understanding of the Christian faith, and have an understanding of the integration of faith and learning as well as faith and the working world.

Ideal candidates will possess a doctorate in a BLM-related field with preference given to those with an MBA, and a PhD or DBA. Consideration will be given to those with all of the following: 1) an EdD, 2) MBA, and 3) considerable business experience. **Applicants without an earned doctorate will not be considered.** Applicants will need to bring significant for-profit business experience. This might include corporate experience or medium and/or small business leadership and/or ownership. Ideally, this business experience would be in line roles of management (marketing, finance, accounting, operations, etc.) and leadership rather than support or technical roles (HR, IT, quality assurance, engineering, etc.).

The preferred candidate will have undergraduate and graduate-level teaching experience both face-to-face and online. A demonstrated passion for students and business-related disciplines is essential.
